- 2. <u>metaphor</u> compares two things that are not alike by saying that one thing is the other
- 3. **personification** when inanimate objects are given human traits
- 4. **imagery** appeals to the five senses: hearing, sight, touch, smell, and taste
- 5. <u>denotation</u> dictionary definition, direct meaning
- 6. <u>connotation</u> associated meaning of a word, the way a word makes you feel
- 7. <u>contradiction</u> direct opposition between things compared
- 8. <u>textual evidence</u> support used for a position; support must come from paraphrasing or quoting words from a story
- 9. <u>topic sentence</u> sentence, often at the beginning of a paragraph, that tells a passage's main idea
- 10. <u>concluding sentence</u> sentence at the end of a passage that sums up what was presented
