- 1. <u>perseverance</u>- a sticking to a purpose, never giving up
- 2. <u>determination</u>- great firmness in carrying out a purpose
- 3. <u>survival</u>- continue to exist; remain
- 4. <u>wilderness</u>- a wild, uncultivated, or desolate region usually no people live in it
- 5. <u>hatchet</u>- a small ax with a short handle
- 6. <u>indefinite pronoun</u>- a pronoun that does not have a clear antecedent. Example: anybody, somebody, all, few, someone
- 7. setting- the time and place of the action
- 8. <u>plot</u>- the sequence of events in a story
- 9. <u>conflict</u>- a struggle between opposing forces (internal/external)
- 10.<u>foreshadowing</u>- an author's use of clues to hint at what might happen later in the story
